Important News about Donations and Tax Receipts

Very recently we were told that the City of Edmonton - who was informed by Revenue Canada - is no longer able to act as the charitable arm for the building project and therefore no longer able to issue tax receipts to donors on our behalf. We are currently investigating how and why this decision was made, and ask for your patience.

We have been advised by the City that some of you who donated in 2009 will be affected by this decision in that a tax receipt will not be issued. Those affected will be contacted by the building committee shortly to explain further and offer options. Again, we ask for your patience.

Regardless of the policy change, we are still accepting donations from anyone wishing to support this project financially. Although a tax receipt will not be issued, please consider donating anyway, as we are applying for grants and other funding sources that have the potential to double your donation for our cause.
